### **Costumes**

Your costumes will be steamed and ready at the high school when you come for dress rehearsal. Tights will be provided in your costume bag. You are responsible for bringing your dance shoes in the correct color! Your dancer will need to arrive for dress rehearsal and performances with hair and makeup done. When you arrive at the high school, find your dressing room, and the Costume Moms will give you your costume.

When your dancer is done performing, the costume and all parts must be placed back in the bag and returned to the Costume Mom in your dressing room before leaving the school.

Costumes may be taken home after your dancer's final performance. If your dancer is performing both Friday and Saturday night, they will wait until after Saturday's performance to take costumes home. If they only dance Friday, they may take costumes home that night.

# **Makeup**

#### Please use:

- Foundation matching your dancer's skintone
- Blush in a rosy pink color
- Eye shadow in earth tones that bring out your dancer's eyes (not bright blue)
- Mascara
- Eyeliner (Optional)
- Lipstick in a classic shade of red

Please do NOT leave makeup, especially lipstick, with little dancers in the dressing room. Yes, it's happened, and no, it wasn't good. If you feel you need to leave lipstick with the Costume Mom, please have your dancer's name on the lipstick and in a small baggie.

## <u>Hair</u>

All dancers in Level 1 Combo and up need to have their hair in a **LOW BUN** at the nape of the neck so as not to interfere with any hats. You might need a hairnet to hold the "whispys" in place and LOTS of hairspray. Pre-Dance and Beginners need to have their hair off their face.

## Jewelry & Nail Polish

NO jewelry and NO nail polish are allowed during dress rehearsal and performance nights. This includes hair-ties around your wrists, thread bracelets/anklets, Fitbit /Apple Watch/or other activity trackers, etc. If you have pierced ears, tiny studs are fine.
